## KC Free Health Clinic Facebook Page

The Kansas City Free Health Clinic is taking advantage of social networking site Facebook to keep in contact with future professionals. Each year, students provide services to General Medical/Dental patients and Community Services clients during academic field placements (also known as practicum, residency or internship).

Alumni and current students with a Facebook account can request to join, KC Free Students & Alumni Group or visit Kansas City Free Health Clinic Students Fanpage (select Become a Fan). Facebook will offer another venue to network, keep up-to-date on Clinic volunteer and job opportunities, participate in fundraisers, and stay in-the-know with Clinic news.

The Fanpage and Group are currently administrated by Clinic Field Instructors, but plans are underway to support student leadership. Administrative students arriving in the fall will keep the pages current with Clinic news, facilitated healthcare discussions, interactive projects and volunteer/learning opportunities. Networking will include status postings and photos of students living the Clinic vision statement of creating solutions for a healthy community!

Students are advised that personal profile information may be available to other group members including staff, volunteers, supervisors, school administrators and instructors. While this is considered a closed-group (limited only to members), students are encouraged to use the "Limited Profile" option to avoid sharing too much. In addition, students are expected to utilize social networking and other internet sites only for academic/work specific activities during the workday.
